Sir Walter Scott lay dying and asked for his Bible and read “[Let not your heart be troubled, you believe in God believe also in me](#)” (John 14:1).

A lost woman in a broken down car called the AA to be told that the road she was on did not exist and they couldn't find her. No matter where you are in life the God of heaven knoweth “[Thou God seeth me](#)” (Gen 16:13)

**Readings: Jeremiah 33v1-3, Matthew 14v24-32, Luke 23v39-43**

No matter the the circumstances Jesus is available. Have you ever made that call to the Lord Jesus? “[His hand is not shortened that it cannot save](#)” (Isa 59:1).

Before we make the call for salvation we need to feel the need.

“[All have sinned and come short of the glory of God](#)” (Romans 3:23 )

“[There is none righteous no not one](#)” (Rom 3:10)

One of the disciples, Thomas would say “[Except I shall see in his hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails, and thrust my hand into his side, I will not believe](#)” (John 20:25) - He had to wait a week to see then he would say “[My Lord and my God](#)” (John 20:28). Jesus answered “[Blessed are those who have not seen me and yet believe](#)” (John 20:29)

“[The wages of sin is death but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord](#)” (Romans 6:23).

“[Come unto me all ye that labour and are heavy laden and I will give you rest](#)” (Matthew 11:28).

Others in the boat with Peter weren't prepared to take the step of faith towards the Saviour. When he turned his eyes off the Saviour he began to sink. Peter cried “[Lord save me](#)” (Matt 14:30), with no hesitation the Lord Jesus “[immediately](#)” put forth His hands.

God intervened after Adam's first sin, when he took of the forbidden fruit in the garden, and an offering was made for sin. On the cross Jesus, like Nehemiah, could have said “[I am doing a great work and cannot come down](#)” (Neh 6:3). He borrowed a coin - “[show me a penny](#)” (Luke 20:24) He borrowed a colt (Luke 19:30), He borrowed a boat to preach in (Matt 13:1) – His cross was His own, “[bearing his cross went forth](#)” (John 19:17).

“[He bore our sins in His body on the tree](#)” (1 Peter 2:24)

“[For God so loved the world that he gave His only begotten Son that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish but have everlasting life](#)” (John 3:16).
