Subject: God speaking to men

It is good to listen to the voice of God. He wants to listen to you. You will be changed. He speaks about His Son. God speaks about the last days; we are living in them; it is not long before God will intervene.

Jesus Christ who died, was buried and rose again is coming soon to take all true believers to heaven. The world after that will not be one people want to live in. God will judge the world of mankind who have rejected the Saviour.

“Perilous times..lovers of self”(2 Ti 3:1)

God speaks about the last message, the greatest message: His Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, full of glory and beauty. There never been a person like Him and there never will be. He was born in Bethlehem, laid in a manger. He is the One Who came down to earth from heaven. He did miracles and blessed men and women.

He speaks about His death. Calvary's cross is the central theme of any gospel message.

“without the shedding of blood there is no remission” (Heb 9:22). The only way that can be forgiven is by the blood of His son (1 John 1:7). There's no gospel, no hope and no cleansing without the blood of Christ. The only way to be right with God is to be cleansed by the blood of the Lamb.

“The blood of Jesus Christ cleanseth us from all our sin” - continual, complete cleansing.

Satan is the accuser of the saints.

If you get saved you'll never be lost (John 10:28). He will give you a new life. Are you glad the blood cleanseth from sin? Do you know anything about it? He wants to cleanse you by His precious blood. He wants to take you to heaven. Not popular to speak about judgment. You will meet Him whether you believe or not. You will be judged if you're not saved. You'll be cast out into the lake of fire. “whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.” (Rev 20:11-15)

The believers in heaven will sing a song of the blood that cleanseth. Those not saved will sob.

You cannot get to heaven after this life is over.

Where can you go for refuge? God wants you to come to Christ and accept Him as your personal Saviour. Are you prepared to accept Him and serve him forever? If you want your sins cleansed tell the Lord Jesus about it. Trust Him.
