Turn from presenter to preacher

1 Cor ch 15 v 1-5

The Gospel is God's most important message to us.

God has revealed the wonder of His love in His Son who has made a sacrifice that we might know God. Through the preaching of the Gospel is how we get saved. We preach to you a Saviour who died on the cross but rose again. We preach a living Saviour who will come back again for His own.

If you are not saved you have to put your trust in the Lord Jesus Christ.

Question on a public billboard:

“What must I do to be saved?”

Most important question ever asked in your life.

There are really only two classes of people

Saved or lost.

Rescued or Perished.

There are two classes of spirituality: Souls saved and ready to meet God and those lost without God for all eternity.

Romans 3 v 23

God reminding us that we have a sinful nature and do things that displease God. God is holy, righteous and spotless.

There is a great gulf between man and God. We have different standards of living but the gulf is so large none of us no matter how good we are would be able to cross that gulf.

Sin has broken our relationship with God. There is a way back. Our sin has got to be dealt with. God punished His son the Lord Jesus Christ. He poured out His judgment - his righteous wrath for you sins and mine. The Lord Jesus died to take the penalty for our sin - made provision for our sin.

It is not enough to believe there is a God and His Son. We have to be prepared to put our trust in Him. Those who believe in His name, who believe in Him and become a child of God.

This is a priority question. A personal question which comes individually. We are born, die and are saved as individuals. This is a pressing question - don't leave it too late.

There are three things not to do to be saved.

1 – Do not sit back and do nothing. We are body, soul and spirit.

People live without God for life then just expect to end up in heaven when they've rejected God on earth.

2 – Do not imagine you cannot do what God required.

The way to become a Christian is simple. There is none that cannot be saved.

3 – Do not procrastinate (put it off)

God is offering you salvation of your soul for today.

God has done it all for you. Salvation is a gift that needs to be accepted.

“by grace are ye saved through faith” (Eph 2:8). There is nothing you need to do to earn it.

“Seek ye the Lord while He may be found” (Isaiah 55:6)

You must repent: admit you are a sinner and confess the sin

Commitment to the Lord - God wants you to come, believe and trust in the Lord Jesus Christ.

Confess Christ as Lord.

Romans 10 v 9

Guaranteed Salvation.

Saul persecuted Christians then accepted Christ as Lord. He was an intellectual scholar.

Lydia's heart was opened and she was an upright pillar of the community.

There was a little girl controlled by spirits - young people are enslaved to addictions but can be freed.

Jailor cried out “What must I do to be saved?”. The answer was “Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ.

“Prepare to meet thy God” (Amos 4:8)

Think of the words of Genesis “In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth”. Think of the words of Revelation that every one will stand before God (Rev 20:12)

John 3 v 16

Get right with God - you simply have to come, admit you are a sinner and put your trust in God.
