Reading: 2 Kings ch 20 v 1-5

There is an advertising slogan on the buses in London which read "There is PROBABLY no God"

We would like to introduce you to the living God - the God in control. Every single human being will have to give and account to Him.

The God of the Bible SPEAKS
The God of the Bible HEARS
The God of the Bible SEES
The God of the Bible HEALS

Hezekiah believed and trusted God, but the question is, Does God speak today?

God speaks in His creation. He is an architect and He planned it all.

He speaks today through His word, the Bible. In a world full of lies, innuendo and doubts the Bible is truth: "Thy word is truth" (John 17:17). His words have a purpose: "Faith cometh by hearing" (Rom 10:17).

God has provided a Saviour. God has spoken in His Son. God sent His Son 2000 years ago into the world to go to the cross and die. "Behold the Lamb of God that taketh away the sin of the world" (John 1:29); "I am the way the truth and the life no man cometh to the Father but by Me" (John 14:6).

The only way we will get right with God is through His Son. "Neither is there Salvation in any other... No other name under heaven" (Acts 4:12)

The sin that keeps you out of heaven has been dealt with.

If God is speaking are we going to listen?

God could stop speaking to you. If He is speaking, respond: Do not ignore Him.

In the passage Hezekiah has been told he is going to die - "no one knows what a day may bring forth" (Prov 27:1). "All have sinned and come short of the glory of God" (Rom 3:23) We are all sinners no matter how good we think we are. "All our righteousnesses as filthy rags" (Isa 64:6)

Two men went to pray in the temple one man said he was glad not to be a sinner the other cried to the Lord saying "God be merciful to me a sinner" (Luke 18:9-14). Which prayer did God hear?

God wants to hear our prayer acknowledging our need. There is nothing that we think or do that God does not see. God knows everything there is to know about you but loves you just the same.

God has done something about our sin. It's like a disease, inherited and can be traced back to one man's disobedience and death by sin. The Lord Jesus Christ was the only man who ever did no sin. Sin can ravish our life's if we let it. It condemns us to a lost eternity in hell.

Is it possible to have your sins forgiven?

God dealt with sin forever at Calvary. God has told us what we have to do to get to heaven. God showed His satisfaction of the work on the cross by raising Him on the third day and He now lives in heaven. God is satisfied with the work of the Lord Jesus Christ.

A jailor in Philippi discovered one night that he had two men who did not deserve to be in prison. At midnight the men were singing praises to God. There was an earthquake and the jailor thinking that the prisoners would escape was going to take his own life. The men stopped him and he that asked them:

“What must I do to be saved?” (Acts 16:30)

Jailor discovered God was real. The answer is still the same today.

“Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ and thou shalt be saved” (Acts 16:31)

Do you know this God? There is no probably about it: God exists. He wants a relationship with you. God expects you to trust Him. He has provided the way if you only trust Him.
