Subject: 3 important births

Readings: Job 14v1-10, Matthew 1v18-25, John 1v10-13

1. Job 14 – Man born of a woman
2. Matthew 1 – The Man born of a Virgin
3. John 1 – The Saint born of God

There is only one Saviour, the man out of heaven, God's man. Who are you in fellowship with? There is only one God, Our God is still on the throne. Are you in fellowship with Him? Is heaven going to be your eternal home?

What do these verses teach us?

1. Man born of a woman is a sinner. There is no other way to come into the world. You need a Saviour more than you need your next meal. Man's days are short.

“You know not what on the morrow” (Proverbs 27:1)

“What is your life? It is even a vapour”(James 4:14)

On this planet we make the greatest decisions of life. Where are you heading for eternity? Are you ready to meet God?

“I was shapen in iniquity and in sin did my mother conceive me”(Ps 51:5). We are sinners by birth and we cannot avoid the fact but we can change it.

Have you got a new life from God?

“Behold now is the accepted time, behold now is the day of salvation”(2.Cor 6:3)

God is giving you another chance, what if He doesn't give you anymore?

We are sinners separated from God (Is 55:7); we need to turn around (or repent)

Life is sorrowful, it is a shadow. How fickle it is we are only a breath away from God and we need to return to God.

“At Calvary's cross is where you begin when you come as a sinner to Jesus”.

2. Man born of a virgin is a Saviour. Do you have a Saviour tonight? Are your sins forgiven?

You may ask, “How can anyone save one like me?”

– There was no human instrumentality at the conception of Christ. Nothing of Mary in Christ.

Mary was a sinner who “rejoiced in God My Saviour” (Luke 1:46). It was divine conception under divine protection. He is the only Saviour, holy and pure, God of very God, untainted by man's sin. He is the fit man to save. If He is not virgin born then we can never be in heaven.

“But we see Jesus who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death”(Heb 2:9).

He is the only one who could pay the ransom price and it must be in precious blood (1 Peter 1:19) because “He bear our sins in His body to the tree” (1 Peter 2:24)

Do you believe you are a sinner? Jesus is the man who can meet your need and hear your cry. Do not go on without the Saviour. You may never have another chance. Settle your peace with God tonight.

3. Man born of God is a saint. This is a miracle. A sinner becomes a separated one for God; a sinner saved by grace.

Are you a sinner saved by grace?

You can be made righteous tonight if you put your hand in His hand.

Are you on the way to heaven?

You need to own up your guilt as a sinner and accept Christ as your Saviour.

“God willeth not the death of any but that all should come to repentance” (1 Tim 2:4, 2 Peter 3:9)

Real life is to be found only in the man who gave His life (1 Tim 2:5,6).

Romans 10:9 make this clear. “If thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved”.

You must receive him for time and all eternity.
