God loves us, Christ died for us. We are all sinners who need a Saviour. “[Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners](#)”(1.Ti 1:15).

Are we saved? Are we bound for glory?

“[Prepare to meet thy God](#)”(Amos 4:12)

Because we are sinners the righteousness of God condemns us. Salvation full and free us available to all because Christ died for sin.

Is it well with your soul? Are you sure your sins are forgiven?

The passage tells us of the siege in Samaria.

It was a hopeless situation. It takes place in a walled city with a gate and the people were starving. The cruel king surrounded the city and it was under siege with people trapped inside. They needed salvation and deliverance from the situation. They needed a Saviour, someone you need to do for you what you cannot do for yourself.

This is a picture of a needy world which has turned its back on God. “[whole world guilty before God](#)” “[no difference, all have sinned](#)” (Rom 3:23).

“[God is of purer eyes than to behold iniquity](#)” (Hab 1:13) - He must be consistent with His righteous character. He must condemn sin even though He loves the sinner.

“[The wages of sin is death but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord](#)”(Rom 6:23), blessings all on basis of our Lord Jesus Christ. Salvation is available through faith in Christ. “[Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ and thou shalt be saved](#)”(Acts 16:31).

“[There is therefore now no condemnation to them that are in Christ Jesus](#)”(Rom 8:1).

“[Whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved](#)” (Rom 10:13)

“[He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life](#)” (John 3:36).

Elisha told the people the words of God and was immediately ridiculed for it.

There were 4 lepers outside the city and they surveyed the options open to them. The leprosy they had is a picture of the sin that we have.

Isa 1:18 – Have you considered the options?

It came to pass as God said. He intervened and saved the situation. God intervened for us and sent His Son into the world. “[The Father sent the Son to be the Saviour of the world](#)” (1 John 4:14)

If you neglect tonight you will pay the cost in eternity.

Have you got everlasting life tonight?

“He that believeth not shall not see life but the wrath of God abideth on him.” (John 3:36)

Turn in repentance towards God and put faith in Jesus Christ.

Is He your Saviour?

He came to seek and to save the lost (Luke 19:10). That people might have life and have it more abundantly (John 10:10).

“Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners” (1 Tim 1:5)

“Christ hath once suffered for sins” (1 Pet 3:18)

“He that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out” (John 6:37)
