Reading: Proverbs 15v3

Each one of us needs the word of God. Need to live by word and die by the word.

May think you can do things and not be seen. Neighbours, police and parents aren't everywhere but God is.

“Believe God must believe that He is” (Heb 11:6).

The eyes of God can see our situation, can see our hearts and minds.

God declares in His word things that are evil and things that are good. God put one limitation upon the garden of Eden. “But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die” (Gen 2:17).

God had used to walk with Adam and commune with Adam. In time both Adam and Eve took the fruit, “Eve saw the fruit that it was good” (Gen 3:6).

What does God see in you and I?

Hagar went out into the wilderness because she fell out with her boss. Hagar was by the well and struggling when God spoke to her. She could say, “thou God seest me” (Gen 16:13). She realised the God of heaven could see her personally.

He sees us in our circumstances and wants to deal with us in our circumstances.

1 Sam 16 – Prophet sent to find a king. He was sent to Jesse who had many sons, each one seeming better than on one before “look not... man looketh on outward appearance but Lord looketh on heart” (1 Sam 16:7).

God is interested in where your heart is in relation to Him.

David was a “man after God's own heart” (1 Sam 13:14).

God can change hearts, He can cleanse our hearts and make us right with Him.

The Lord Jesus died on Calvary “that He might cleanse from all unrighteousness” (1 John 1:9).

It is the sin in our hearts that keeps us back from God.

The old testament often shows how God brought His people out and kept them. He can do the same for us today. “Seen affliction of people in Egypt and come down to deliver”, “when I see the blood I will pass over you” (Ex 12:13). A lamb was slain and blood protected the people from the angel of death. This was a picture of what God would do to His Son “Behold the lamb of God which taketh away the sin of the world” (John 1:29).

God sent His Son into the world to die for me and you.

Each one of us are born under threat of eternal death.

As seen at the time of passover they were those who had been affected by the death and those

shielded by the blood who weren't. The blood in the basin had no effect. It was only when it was applied that it had any value.

Until we accept the blood and have faith in His work it is valueless.

The blood of the Lord Jesus is more precious than gold. It is able to cleanse from sin.

The Lord Jesus knows our hearts, He didn't need to be told about any man. He knows He can cleanse our hearts and make us right with God.

“[The Lord knoweth them that are His](#)” (2 Tim 2:19).

Have you ever put your faith in the Lord Jesus?

Have you realised you are a sinner and asked for salvation?

Salvation is not dependent on us, our ability or memory. It is dependent entirely on the Christ of the cross. Our part is to accept the salvation that is offered to us.
