Subject: The Hand of God

Reading of the word of God is important. The Bible comes to us from the God of heaven. The God of heaven is interested in you and has devised a way you can be reconciled to Him.

**Psalm 8v1-9**      “When I consider the heavens, the work of thy fingers”(v3)

The Lord Jesus is the Son of God and everything is brought about by Him. Man cannot grasp the wonder and size of the universe, but in contrast, “What is man?”

Only life elsewhere is in heaven and you won't get there by technology or by yourself.

He is above all and above everything. You and I are responsible to Him as creator God.

Men had been placed on earth as God had a plan for you and me. He has a desire that heaven be populated with all those who come to Him.

Christ is the eternal Son of God and He gives you everything. He calls you to come to Him, “Come unto me all ye that labour and are heavy laden and I will give you rest”(Matt 11:28).

**Daniel 5v17-30**      “and the God in whose hand thy breath is”(v23)

We receive our every breathe from the palm of His hands. The message is urgent. We may not be here tomorrow. Before the end of the night here Belshazzar was in eternity.

Your first breath came from His hand, it makes us responsible to Him. Without Him we would have no existence.

Your every breath will come from His hand, makes us rely on Him 100%. have you ever given God thanks for the breathe you breath?

Your last breath will be given you by Him. We don't know when that is. We should reverence Him for He will decide when last breathe will be.

“Boast not thyself of to morrow; for thou knowest not what a day may bring forth” (Prov 27:1)

This might be the last night God will keep His hand open with your breath in it.

**Luke 24v36-40**      “He showed them His hands”(v40)

The Lord Jesus had been crucified on the cross, nailed there by cruel sinners. To show who He is and what He has done He shows His hands and His feet.

To show His love to you. He has done something far greater.

The Lord Jesus Christ knew what would happen to Him in Jerusalem. He knew what had been recorded, “They pierced My hands and My feet” (Ps 22:16). He knew what would happen and could have been anywhere else but He came here. Why? Because He loved you. “For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life” (John 3:16). “While we were yet sinners Christ died for us” (Rom 5:8).

His love endured, He stayed on the cross. There was no one else who could save, “[God made to meet upon Him the iniquity of us all](#)” (Isa 53:6).

When men cried “[save Thyself](#)” He would only think of saving you and me and He stayed there on the cross.

Luke 24:46-48

“[For the joy that was set before Him, endured cross, despising shame](#)”.

Do you still sit with sin as a heavy burden? It will separate you from God for all eternity. Have you ever been to Calvary? There the Saviour paid the price for sin. The preacher could say “[The Son of God loved me and gave Himself for me](#)” can you?

One day you will see Him, all you have done will be written in books. The hands knock on the hearts door. Rev 3:20. If you continue to ignore “[fearful thing to fall into hands of living God](#)” (Heb 10:31). Don't forget how fearful He is. He answers to no one but you and I must answer to Him.

“[And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire](#)” (Revelation 20:15)

He is coming back, “[For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first](#)” (1 Thess 4:16).

“[And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away](#)” (Revelation 21:4)

Secure for all eternity. “[And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand](#)” (John 10:28)

Do you have assurance that when you see Him you will go to be with Him?

Important thing tonight is that we have got rid of sin and have got Him.

Don't have to wait for heaven for hand of God He will be with you in life too.

“[The Father loveth the Son, and hath given all things into his hand](#)” (John 3:35). His hands are in control of everything. Your eternal destiny is dependent on what He does with you. It will depend on what you do with Him. He went to the cross for you. He knew all about you. He allowed Himself to be crucified for you and me.
